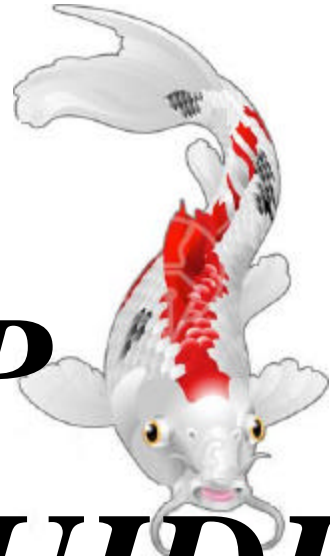


Payment

- We require one lump-sum payment upon arrival. We accept cash, cheque, debit, VISA or MasterCard.
- Coupons not accepted for school programs.
- Pre-K to Grade 7: one teacher/adult per 5 students admitted free.
- Secondary: one teacher/adult per 10 students admitted free.
- Cancellation Policy: Without 48 hours notice of cancellation, the full booking fee will be charged.


Things to Note

- Please check-in at Visitor Services upon arrival.
- The Garden is an indoor/outdoor facility. Dress appropriately for outdoor conditions.
- There are no lunchroom facilities; students may eat in the public courtyard outside.
- There are no cloakrooms or storage. Please leave unnecessary and valuable items at home or school.
- There is a free 2 hour bus parking zone on Keefer street (at Carrall). Cars can use the Floata parkade (Keefer/Columbia).



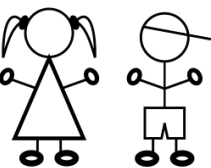
B. Organize Transportation

- Bus: Free two hour bus parking on the corner of Keefer Street at Carrall Street. Public transit is available. Bus # 19 or #22 will stop along Pender at Carrall.
- Cars: Street parking or try the parkade at Keefer Street and Columbia Street
- Other: Use the Stadium/Chinatown skytrain exit. The Garden is 2 blocks East



C. Plan for Payment

- We require payment upon arrival. We accept cash, cheque, Debit, VISA or MasterCard. Coupons and passes not accepted for school programs
- Pre-K to Grade 7: One teacher/adult per 5 students admitted free



D. Students Checklist

- Name Tags: Make nametags for younger students. It will make it easier to identify each student and the group they arrived with.
- Dress Code: Please note that the Garden is an indoor/outdoor facility with some portions of the programme delivered outside. We recommend students dress appropriately for outdoor conditions.

E. Garden Guidelines

- Behaviour: Group leaders are responsible for student behaviour. We reserve the right to "sit out" students for aggressive, disruptive or dangerous behaviour
- Food: Lunchroom facilities are not available; students may bring lunches and eat in the Dr. Sun Yat-Sen courtyard (weather permitting)
- Valuables for storage: Cloakroom/storage rooms not available; please leave all unnecessary and valuable items at home or school.
The Garden is not responsible for lost or damaged items
- Cancellation Policy: Without 48 hours notice of cancellation, the full booking fee will be charged
- The Garden is wheelchair accessible; entry through the Gift Shop



F. Remember to Bring

G. Upon Arrival

- Arrive 10 minutes before your scheduled program time. Please call 604-662-3207 ext. 200 if you are arriving late
- The entrance is located facing Pender Street. Look for two lanterns and a red carpet which will lead you to our Admissions Area. Please have your students wait outside while you come in and pay. Your Garden guide will be waiting for you to lead in everyone together.
