Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden is delighted to offer a Photographer Pass Holder. This yearly pass provides benefits created specifically for professional and amateur photographers including the ability to sell photos of the Garden, promotional opportunities for the photographers and additional access to the Garden.

A Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden Photographer Pass includes:

- Unlimited annual admission to the Garden
- Exclusive admission to the Garden on Mondays between 9 am and 5 pm from November 1 to April 30 (Closed to the public. By appointment*)
- Admission to seasonal Photographer Pass-Only hours
- Invitation to submit photographs for use in Garden's printed materials, website and social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter & Instagram)

- Exclusive Pass-Holder-only events
- Discounted rates for most Garden concerts, workshops and other unique events
- Subscription to monthly e-newsletter
- 10% discount in Eight Treasures Shop

Rate

Adult Photographer Pass: \$75/year

Upgrade to Adult Photographer Pass from any current Adult Annual Pass level \$30

Senior/Student Photographer Pass: \$60/year

Upgrade to Senior/Student Photographer Pass from current Senior/Student Annual Pass: \$25 A Photographer Pass is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Policies for all Photographers

We ask all photographers to please honour these policies while taking photos at the Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden.

- All equipment (tripods, lighting, props, screens, etc.) must be lifted and not pushed or dragged across the terra cotta floor tiles or pebbled courtyards. Lift/carry bulky or heavy items to prevent potential nicks to walls, decorative woodwork and flooring
- Do not climb or stand on rocks, terra cotta ledges, banisters/railings as, over time, the materials have become fragile and are irreplaceable
- Tri-pod feet must be non-abrasive; rubber feet are accepted. Metal, spikes and plastic feet must be covered with tennis balls (some available on loan at the Garden)
- Do not hang, staple, glue, tape or tie anything to rocks, terra cotta ledges, banisters/ railings
- Do not touch or move Garden plants, displays or artifacts

- We are a smoke-free environment. We do not allow food, drinks (other than bottled water), or pets in the Garden
- Ting, mountain and cave access is off-limits (no climbing or entry) unless previously authorized by the Garden in writing
- When Garden is open to the public, photographers will be mindful of how the Garden space is shared with other groups, guests and tours. Do not block any pathways or ask guests to remove themselves from your shot
- Garden assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to equipment
- Final decisions about site use rests with Garden's on-site supervisor or staff person designated. Supervisor's approval must be granted before being implemented.

IMPORTANT: Portrait photography is not included in this Pass. Portrait photography includes all wedding, family, and engagement photos, and any other posed portrait by either professional or amateur photographers when the Garden is used as a backdrop. Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden reserves the right to further define Portrait Photography.

Conditions

Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden maintains the right to adjust these policies, in specific instances, in the best interests of the Garden, its staff, and the general public. The Photographer Member agrees to release form liability and to indemnify and hold harmless Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden, it's staff, docents and other representatives from any claim for personal injury and loss of/or damage to property, including negligence, arising in connection with or resulting from the use of Garden facilities.

The Garden requires the location credit "Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden" in all uses of Garden photos in print, on the web, in broadcast, and in any other public medium.

Photo rights & usage

The Garden may request from Photographer Pass-holders Garden images for Garden promotion. We welcome the submission of Garden images from all Photographer Pass-holders at any time.
